Plain Language Summary

This study is looking at a surgical treatment for a serious eye condition called central retinal artery occlusion — which is basically a 'stroke' in the eye that can cause sudden vision loss. The surgery involves gently massaging the blocked artery inside the eye to try to break up the blockage and restore blood flow and vision.

You may be eligible if:

- You have been diagnosed with central retinal artery occlusion within the last 4 days
- You do not have other eye diseases that are affecting your vision

You may NOT be eligible if:

- Your eye blockage happened more than 4 days ago
- You have other eye conditions that significantly affect your vision

Talk to your doctor about whether this trial might be right for you.

Key Eligibility Criteria

Inclusion (1)

- typical central retinal artery occlusion occurred within 4 days

Exclusion (1)

- with other eye diseases that affect vision
