

# Comparison of 0.8% sevoflurane versus Entonox for labour analgesia

## Plain Language Summary

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This study compares two methods of pain relief during labor: breathing in a gas called Entonox (laughing gas) versus using a new inhaler device that delivers 0.8% sevoflurane. Both methods are used by mothers during contractions to reduce pain without an epidural.

You may be eligible if:

- You are a healthy woman in active labor
- You have no significant medical or surgical health conditions

You may NOT be eligible if:

- You have any medical or surgical health conditions that could affect you or your baby

Talk to your doctor about whether this trial might be right for you.

## Key Eligibility Criteria

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### Inclusion (1)

- Healthy parturients in active labour with no medical or surgical comorbidities

### Exclusion (1)

- Any coexisting medical or surgical comorbidities to mother and fetus
