## Plain Language Summary

---

This study is for people having a total knee replacement. After the surgery, managing pain well is very important so patients can move around, avoid complications, and recover faster. This trial tests 10 different methods of pain relief — including nerve blocks and combinations of medications — to find out which approach works best.

You may be eligible if:

- You are 18 years of age or older
- You are scheduled for a planned (elective) total knee replacement surgery

You may NOT be eligible if:

- You are having only a partial (unicompartmental) knee replacement
- You refuse to participate
- You have a medical reason why you cannot have spinal or regional anesthesia
- You are allergic to any of the medications used in this study

Talk to your doctor about whether this trial might be right for you.

## Key Eligibility Criteria

---

### Inclusion (1)

- Patients scheduled for total knee arthroplasty

### Exclusion (1)

- unicompartmental knee arthroplasty, refusal to participate, contraindication to spinal or regional anesthesia and/or allergy to the drugs used
