

A clinical registry to monitor outcomes of shoulder, hip and knee pathology

Plain Language Summary

This is a research registry — not a treatment trial — that collects information about patient outcomes after shoulder, hip, and knee treatment. Patients treated by participating orthopaedic surgeons at QEII Jubilee Hospital are invited to have their outcomes tracked over time. This helps researchers identify which treatments work best, spot unexpected results, and build evidence for better care. Participation mainly involves completing questionnaires about your symptoms, function, and quality of life.

You may be eligible if:

- You are 16 years of age or older
- You have been diagnosed with a shoulder, hip, or knee condition by a participating orthopaedic surgeon
- You are receiving treatment as a public patient at QEII Jubilee Hospital
- You are willing to have your health data collected for research

You may NOT be eligible if:

- You have a clinically diagnosed mental or neurological condition (such as schizophrenia or dementia) that prevents you from completing questionnaires
- You do not consent to the use of your data for research

Talk to your doctor about whether this trial might be right for you.

Key Eligibility Criteria

Inclusion (3)

- Diagnosed with orthopaedic shoulder, hip or knee pathology in one of the identified cohorts.
- Undergoing treatment by one of the participating orthopaedic consultant surgeons as a public patient at QEII Jubilee Hospital.
- Consenting to being part of the research registry

Exclusion (2)

- Patient-reported outcomes: Clinically diagnosed mental/neurological illness (indicated on GP referral, or identified through secondary referral to psychiatric/neurological specialist) that precludes retrieval of patient feedback via interview, paper or electronic questionnaire (e.g., schizophrenia, dementia, Alzheimer's Disease, personality disorder).
- Revocation of consent for research use of personal data.
