

# National Dermatology Radiation Oncology Registry: A multi-site Registry recording clinical observations of patients referred for radiotherapy for the management of skin cancers and inflammatory skin diseases

## Plain Language Summary

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This registry is collecting detailed information about patients who receive radiotherapy for skin cancer or difficult-to-treat inflammatory skin conditions across multiple cancer centres in Australia. Radiotherapy is an effective treatment for many skin conditions, but comprehensive data on its outcomes, safety, and tolerability in dermatology has not been systematically collected in Australia before.

Participants who have been referred by their dermatologist to a radiation oncologist will have their medical history, treatment details, and outcomes recorded in a secure online database. The information collected will be used to produce research publications and improve clinical practice guidelines for dermatological radiotherapy.

You may be eligible if you are 18 or older, have a skin cancer or inflammatory skin condition that your dermatologist has referred for radiotherapy treatment, and are willing to consent to your information being recorded. The only exclusion is declining to provide consent.

## Key Eligibility Criteria

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### Inclusion (4)

- over 18 years of age
- diagnosed with a treatable skin cancer or inflammatory skin condition by a dermatologist
- eligible to be treated using radiotherapy
- patient has voluntarily signed and dated informed consent/patient authorisation form

### Exclusion (1)

- patients who do not consent to their involvement in the registry
