## Plain Language Summary

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This study is evaluating people with kidney diseases caused by the immune system — such as lupus-related kidney disease or various types of kidney inflammation — to better understand and treat these conditions.

**\*\*You may be eligible if...\*\***

- You are 18 years of age or older (or a child aged 10–17)
- You have a known, suspected, or proven immune-related kidney disease (such as nephrotic syndrome, lupus nephritis, membranous nephropathy, or glomerulonephritis)
- You have an immune-related disease that may eventually affect the kidneys

**\*\*You may NOT be eligible if...\*\***

- You have other medical problems that would complicate the study's findings
- You have other conditions for which the NIH cannot provide adequate care or funding

Talk to your doctor to see if this trial is right for you.

## Key Eligibility Criteria

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### Inclusion (6)

- In order to be eligible to participate in this study, a participant must meet all of the following criteria:
- Adults  $\geq$  18 years of age and children 10-17 years of age
- Participants with
- known, proven, or suspected immunologically-mediated kidney diseases, including but not limited to nephrotic syndrome, glomerulonephritis, membranous nephropathy, lupus nephritis, and nephritis associated with other systemic or connective tissue disorders, OR
- immunologically-mediated diseases with the potential for kidney disease.

### Exclusion (3)

- An individual who meets any of the following criteria will be excluded from participation in this study:
- Concomitant medical problems which would confound the interpretation of studies of the immunologic kidney disorder.
- Concomitant medical, surgical, or other conditions for which inadequate facilities or funds are available to support their care at the NIH.
