Key Eligibility Criteria

Inclusion (2)

- Patient referred for elective coronary angiography because of a reasonable clinical suspicion of coronary ischemia.
- Presence of angina or an anginal equivalent (including chest, back, shoulder, arm, neck, jaw discomfort, or shortness of breath brought on by physical exertion, emotional stress, or certain times of day/month).

Exclusion (12)

- Asymptomatic (such as a pre-op cath)
- Status-post heart transplant
- Age ≤ 18
- Renal insufficiency (creatinine ≥ 1.5)
- Presence of an acute coronary syndrome (STEMI or NSTEMI), Tako-tsubo, an abnormal ejection fraction (EF $\leq 55\%$), cardiogenic shock, or recent VT/VF
- ... and 7 more (see full listing online)
