Key Eligibility Criteria

Inclusion (15)

- Recent (e6 months) or remote (i.e., several decades) unilateral or bilateral upper limb loss (below the shoulder) desiring limb transplantation.
- Below-shoulder amputation.
- Functionless or minimally functional hand desiring removal of functionless / minimally functional hand followed by transplantation.
- Male or female and of any race, color or ethnicity.
- Aged 18-69 years.

Exclusion (36)

- No co-existing psycho-social problems (i.e., alcoholism, drug abuse).
- Negative for malignancy for past 5 years.
- Negative for HIV at transplant.
- Negative crossmatch with donor.
- If female of child-bearing potential, negative serum pregnancy test.
