Key Eligibility Criteria

Inclusion (3)

- Fully understanding and willing to undergo study procedures
- Male or Female greater than or equal to 18 years of age
- Understanding and willing to sign consent form.

Exclusion (8)

- History of cardiovascular, pulmonary, or neurological disease
- Hypertension (sitting blood pressure \geq 140/90 mmHg, with measurements recorded on at least 2 occasions)
- Diabetes
- Unable to give informed consent;
- Contra-indication to CMRI testing, including claustrophobia and metallic implants
