## Plain Language Summary

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This study is setting up a telehealth screening program to identify mental health and emotional support needs in patients with newly diagnosed head and neck cancer who are having surgery.

**\*\*You may be eligible if...\*\***

- You are 18 years old or older
- You have been newly diagnosed with head and neck cancer (not a recurrence)
- Your primary treatment is surgery

**\*\*You may NOT be eligible if...\*\***

- You are under 18
- Your head and neck cancer has come back after a previous treatment
- You have previously received chemotherapy or radiation therapy
- You have a history of psychiatric or psychological illness
- You have had other cancers before or have experienced cancer-related emotional distress previously

Talk to your doctor to see if this trial is right for you.

## Key Eligibility Criteria

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### Inclusion (3)

- years
- New (non-recurrent) head and neck cancer
- Primary surgical treatment

### Exclusion (5)

- <18 years
- Recurrent head and neck cancer
- Previous chemotherapy or radiation therapy
- History of psychiatric or psychologic illness
- History of previous cancers or cancer distress
