Key Eligibility Criteria

Inclusion (4)

- \. Age 18 years and older
- \. Already scheduled to undergo an EGD or colonoscopy for screening, surveillance, or a medically-indicated work-up at the University of Maryland Medical Center (main campus or Midtown)
- \. Able to provide written informed consent prior to initiation of any study procedures
- \. Healthy, as defined by considered fit to undergo outpatient elective EGD/colonoscopy by the evaluating health care provider

Exclusion (10)

- \. Pregnancy or nursing mother
- \. Known coagulopathy or bleeding disorder preventing mucosal biopsy
- \. History of Crohn's disease or ulcerative colitis
- \. For Subjects undergoing lower endoscopy (colonoscopy) only: Surgical removal of the ileocecal valve or any part of the small or large intestine (non-complicated appendectomy will be considered eligible)
- \. Allergic reaction to oral typhoid or cholera vaccine in the past
