Key Eligibility Criteria

Inclusion (12)

- group A: patients with acute alcoholic hepatitis
- Active alcohol abuse defined by DSM IV and excessive alcohol consumption prior to admission (≥ 60 g per day for men and ≥ 40 g per day for women)
- Moderate elevation of transaminases (less than 500 U / L) with a typical ASAT / ALAT ratio of 2: 1
- Bilirubin ≥ 50 mg / l
- Absence of autoimmune liver disease (ANA $\leq 1/80$, AML $\leq 1/80$, LKM1 neg, AAM neg)
- ... and 7 more (see full listing online)

Exclusion (12)

- For groups A and B1:
- Patients with hepatocellular carcinoma of progressive non-hepatic cancer
- Presence of HBsAg
- Presence of anti-HCV antibodies by positive PCR
- Presence of antibodies to HIV 1 +2
- ... and 7 more (see full listing online)
