## Key Eligibility Criteria

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### Inclusion (1)

- All infants hospitalized at participating Neonatal Intensive Care Units will be eligible for the study if they meet published criteria for requiring ROP screening examination, or if they are transferred to the study center for specialized ophthalmic care. These eligibility criteria are identical at each study center, and match what is done in standard clinical practice according to national guidelines published jointly by the American Academy of Pediatrics, American Academy of Ophthalmology, and American Association for Pediatric Ophthalmology and Strabismus (AAP-AAO, Pediatrics, 2013).

### Exclusion (1)

- Patients will be excluded if they have structural ocular anomalies, or if they are considered unstable for examination by their attending neonatologist.
