Plain Language Summary

This is a biobank study based in Lyon, France, where researchers are collecting blood and tissue samples from organ transplant recipients over time. The goal is to better understand transplant rejection and improve future treatments by studying biological samples.

****You may be eligible if...****

- You are 18 or older
- You have received an organ transplant
- You are willing to provide written informed consent

****You may NOT be eligible if...****

- You are not enrolled in the French social security system
- You are incarcerated
- You are pregnant or breastfeeding

Talk to your doctor to see if this trial is right for you.

Key Eligibility Criteria

Inclusion (3)

- Male or Female patient e18 years old
- Recipient of an organ transplant
- Written informed consent

Exclusion (3)

- Non-affiliation to a social security system.
- Subjects deprived of liberties
- Pregnant or breastfeeding woman
