Plain Language Summary

This study is collecting information on patients with severe liver scarring (cirrhosis) who need a procedure called TIPS (a small tube placed inside the liver to reduce dangerous pressure in blood vessels) to understand which patients benefit most and how to improve outcomes.

****You may be eligible if...****

- You have liver cirrhosis
- Your doctor has recommended a TIPS procedure
- You are being treated at the gastroenterology department at Hannover Medical School
- You are able to give informed consent

****You may NOT be eligible if...****

- You are pregnant or breastfeeding
- You are under 18 years old
- You have severe heart failure
- You are unable to consent to the study

Talk to your doctor to see if this trial is right for you.

Key Eligibility Criteria

Inclusion (4)

- Liver cirrhosis
- Indication for TIPS insertion
- Treatment at the Department of Gastroenterology, Hepatology and Endocrinology of Hannover Medical School
- Informed consent

Exclusion (4)

- Pregnancy or Lactation
- Age <18 years
- Lack of Informed consent
- Symptomatic anemia with Hb <7g/dl
