## Key Eligibility Criteria

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### Inclusion (1)

- Patients after first trimester miscarriage treated non-surgically with sonographic evidence for the presence of RPOC at follow-up visit after 6 weeks ( $\pm$  1 week) who have an immediate future pregnancy wish and are willing to give informed consent.

### Exclusion (13)

- Women aged below 18 years
- Women aged over 39 years
- Women not wanting to achieve pregnancy within the first 6 months after non-surgical treatment for miscarriage
- Women with a history of repeated miscarriage defined as 3 or more consecutive pregnancy losses before 20 weeks of pregnancy duration
- Women with untreated and/or untreatable subfertility
