Key Eligibility Criteria

Inclusion (4)

- Age between 18 and 65 years
- Traumatic Brain Injury with abnormal CT scan
- Invasive ICP monitoring in place
- ICP \geq 25 mmHg for 1-12h after conventional therapies step I and step II (see Trial flow chart)

Exclusion (6)

- Bilateral fixed and dilated pupil
- Limitation of therapies by the team due to poor prognosis
- Withdrawal of consent
- Severe pre-existing physical or mental disability or co-morbidity which would lead to a poor outcome even if the patient made a full recovery from the head injury
- Intracranial injury mandating craniotomy/craniectomy in itself
