Key Eligibility Criteria

Inclusion (9)

- to 85 years old, male and female
 - Modified Rankin Score (mRS) ≤ 2 prior to stroke
 - Ischemic or hemorrhagic stroke as diagnosed by vascular neurologist or as proven on magnetic resonance imaging (MRI) or non-contrast head computed tomography (NCHCT)
 - hours to 3 weeks after stroke onset or time last known well prior to detection of symptoms
 - National Institute of Health Stroke Scale (NIHSS) ≥ 3 and NIHSS ≤ 15
- ... and 4 more (see full listing online)

Exclusion (18)

- Any degree of receptive aphasia
 - Moderate or severe expressive aphasia
 - Currently pregnant or plans to get pregnant
 - Currently breastfeeding
 - Any patient admitted with primary Subarachnoid hemorrhage (SAH) on either non-contrast head CT or MRI brain
