Key Eligibility Criteria

Inclusion (3)

- International guideline criteria for nodular-bronchiectatic MAC lung disease, i.e. symptomatic, nodular bronchiectatic lesions seen on thorax radiography and e2 positive cultures of the same MAC species or one positive culture from a bronchoalveolar lavage;
- e1 positive MAC sputum cultures must be collected in the previous 4 months;
- Signed and dated patient informed consent.

Exclusion (14)

- Fibrocavitary MAC lung disease;
 - Antimycobacterial treatment in the last 6 months;
 - Previous MAC lung disease treatment failure, defined as persistent culture positivity despite >6 months of guideline-recommended treatment;
 - Current clinical relevant asthma or otherwise bronchial hyperresponsiveness that is judged to be a contra-indication for HSi.
 - Current HSi use
