## Key Eligibility Criteria

---

### Inclusion (3)

- Alert or able to cooperate with treatment.
- Able to give Informed Consent and sign it.
- Haemodynamically stable clinical situation or requiring minimal ventilatory support.

### Exclusion (10)

- Detection of complete paralysis of the diaphragm.
  - Progressive neuromuscular diseases or with spinal cord injury.
  - Lack of collaboration or cooperation, or non-alertness (Glasgow d8).
  - Unstable clinical situation (patients requiring high levels of ventilatory support (e.g., Positive End Expiratory Pressure (PEEP)) > 10 cmH<sub>2</sub>O, Fraction Pressure of Inspired Oxygen (FiO<sub>2</sub>) > 0.60, nitric oxide, nebulised prostacyclin, high frequency oscillation).
  - Clinical situation compromising the patient's recovery (cardiac arrhythmias, acute sepsis).
