Key Eligibility Criteria

Inclusion (5)

- Cantonese-speaking Hong Kong residents
- Living together with the child who is at preschool/school-age (3-8 years old)
- Caregivers who adopted the responsibility of taking care of the child,
- has daily access to their iPhone and Android smartphones.
- In addition, potential eligible parents who respond "yes" to any of the five validated screening questions in the Children with Special Health Care Needs (SHCN) Screener (see <https://www.childhealthdata.org/docs/cshcn/technical-summary-of-cshcn-screener.pdf>) will then be asked the associated follow-up questions to determine whether the child possesses physical, neurodevelopmental/emotional problem(s) that has lasted for at least 12 months. Only children with a positive response(s) to e 1 item in each of the associated follow-up questions will be classified as children with SHCN.

Exclusion (1)

- Parents who have diagnoses of severe mental illness or developmental disabilities, such as intellectual disabilities
