## Key Eligibility Criteria

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### Inclusion (6)

- Male and female, ages of 18 and 85 years and with a prior ICD implant
  - Diagnosed with ischemic cardiomyopathy: Prior myocardial infarction (pathological Q waves or imaging evidence of regional myocardial akinesis/thinning in the absence of a non-ischemic cause)
  - One of the following VT events (within last 6 months): a) e3 episodes of VT treated with anti-tachycardia pacing (ATP) or anti-arrhythmic drugs; b) e1 appropriate ICD shocks; c) e3 VT episodes within 24 hr; d) sustained VT below detection rate of the ICD documented by EKG/cardiac monitor
  - Patients deemed candidates for RF ablation of VT
  - Able and willing to comply with pre-, post-, and follow-up requirements

### Exclusion (14)

- Serum creatinine  $>1.5$  mg/dL, or creatinine clearance  $<30$  ml/min
  - Left ventricular (LV) ejection fraction  $\leq 10\%$
  - Mobile LV thrombus on echocardiography
  - Absence of vascular access to the LV
  - Disease process likely to limit survival to  $<12$  months
