Key Eligibility Criteria

Inclusion (7)

- Patients with permanent occlusion at age 15-20 years.
 - Patients with class II division I (half cusp or Less) with moderate overjet (2-4mm).
 - Patients with normal or horizontal growth pattern.
 - Mild crowding (≤ 2 mm) in maxillary and mandibular arch.
 - Patient with satisfactory periodontal health and good oral hygiene

Exclusion (8)

- Patients with periodontal disease.
 - Patients with vertical growth pattern.
 - Patients with missing or extracted teeth except third molar.
 - Patients with temporomandibular joint disorder.
 - Patients with Skeletal open bite.
