## Key Eligibility Criteria

---

### Inclusion (4)

- Patient older than 18 years.
- Definitive diagnosis of acute lithiasic cholecystitis according to the GP Tokyo 2018 criteria.
- Surgical decision of inoperable patient (if one or more of the following criteria is met: age  $\geq$  80 years, American Society of Anesthesiology (ASA) III or more, Charlson Comorbidity Index  $>$  5 and/or Karnofsky  $<$  50 or decision of the patient not to have surgery.
- Signature of the informed consent of the study

### Exclusion (11)

- Operable acute cholecystitis.
- Refusal of the patient to participate in the study.
- Anatomy of the GI tract altered by previous hepatobiliary or upper GI surgery.
- Ascites.
- Inability to tolerate endoscopy sedation, perforation of the digestive tract, or other contraindication to endoscopy.
