Key Eligibility Criteria

Inclusion (45)

- To be eligible to participate in this trial as a study subject, an individual must meet all of the following criteria:
 - Provision of signed and dated parental permission form
 - Unilateral severe-to-profound sensorineural hearing loss, congenital or acquired prior to the age of 2 years, defined as:
 - Unaided residual hearing thresholds that yield a 3 frequency pure tone average (PTA; average at 500, 1000, and 2000 Hz) of e70 dB hearing loss (HL) in the ear to be implanted
 - Hearing thresholds in the contralateral ear of d20 dB HL (3 frequency PTA of 500, 1000, and 2000 Hz).
