Key Eligibility Criteria

Inclusion (3)

- Age \geq 18 years.
- patients diagnosed with liver cirrhosis.
- Refractory ascites which is defined as ascites failing to resolve after maximum tolerable dose of diuretics, and usually require frequent paracentesis.

Exclusion (4)

- Patients $<$ 18y
- patients with no history of liver cirrhosis
- patients with refractory ascites but have transjugular intrahepatic portosystemic shunts (TIPS) with previous 3 months
- Patients with ascites due to other causes, including cardiac, malignant
