Key Eligibility Criteria

Inclusion (10)

- Patients scheduled to undergo primary total knee replacement with the MAKO-robotic arm, with one of the following indications:
 - Painful, disabling joint disease of the knee resulting from: non-inflammatory degenerative joint disease (including osteoarthritis, traumatic arthritis or avascular necrosis) or rheumatoid arthritis.
 - One or more compartments are involved;
 - Moderate varus, valgus, or flexion deformity in which the ligamentous structures can be returned to adequate function and stability (meaning a varus, valgus or flexion deformity \lt 15 degrees);
 - Age between 18 and 70 years;

Exclusion (27)

- Contraindications manufacturer:
 - Any active or suspected latent infection in or about the knee joint;
 - Distant foci of infection which may cause hematogenous spread to the implant site;
 - Any mental or neuromuscular disorder which would create an unacceptable risk of prosthesis instability, prosthesis fixation failure, or complications in postoperative care;
 - Bone stock compromised by disease, infection or prior implantation which cannot provide adequate support and/or fixation to the prosthesis;
