Key Eligibility Criteria

Inclusion (8)

- between the age of 7 and 17 years
 - has a unilateral limb difference
 - limb difference may be from any cause (congenital difference, traumatic loss, etc.)
 - limb difference may be of any level (partial hand, wrist disarticulation, transradial, elbow disarticulation, transhumeral, shoulder disarticulation)
 - ability to communicate in English
- ... and 3 more (see full listing online)

Exclusion (5)

- less than 7 or greater than 17 years of age
- bilateral or no limb upper limb difference
- inability to communicate in English
- cognitive inability to follow instructions
- unable or unwilling to attend 2 appointments at Rehabilitation Centre for Children
