Plain Language Summary

This study is examining the gut and vaginal microbiome (the community of bacteria and microorganisms living in the gut and vaginal area) in women living with HIV. The goal is to understand how these microbial communities differ in HIV-positive women, including during pregnancy.

****You may be eligible if...****

- You are a woman living with HIV
- You may be pregnant or non-pregnant
- You are willing to sign a consent form

****You may NOT be eligible if...****

- You have never been sexually active
- You are unable or unwilling to provide consent

Talk to your doctor to see if this trial is right for you.

Key Eligibility Criteria

Inclusion (2)

- HIV women including pregnant ;
- sign consent paper

Exclusion (1)

- virgin or maiden
