## Key Eligibility Criteria

---

### Inclusion (6)

- In order to be eligible to participate in this study, an individual must meet all of the following criteria:
- Age  $\geq 18$ -65 years
- HBsAg positive with a level  $< 2,000$  IU/mL at the time of screening
- Hepatitis B e antigen negative
- HBV DNA levels  $< 10,000$  IU/mL on two occasions at least 24 weeks apart with the second being at time of screening
- ... and 1 more (see full listing online)

### Exclusion (30)

- An individual who meets any of the following criteria will be excluded from participation in this study:
- Pregnancy or lactation
- For women of childbearing potential, inability, or unwillingness to use highly effective contraception during study drug dosing and for an additional 24 weeks after the end of study drug administration.
- For males of reproductive potential: Unable or unwilling to use condoms consistently in addition to female partner using another adequate contraceptive method to ensure effective contraception with partner during study participation and for an additional 24 weeks after the end of study medication administration. Patients who have undergone surgical sterilization (vasectomy) will still require female partner to utilize an additional adequate contraception method.
- Known history of hypersensitivity or contraindication to an siRNA, oligonucleotide, or GalNAc or any interferon product
