Key Eligibility Criteria

Inclusion (4)

- Age \geq 18 years old.
- Consent to participate in the study.
- Pain in the flank/lumbar fossa of sudden onset with urine strips and/or imaging corresponding to the diagnosis of renal colic.
- Pain score at discharge \leq 30 (visual analog scale - VAS or verbal numerical scale - VAS from 0 to 100).

Exclusion (3)

- Inability to appreciate pain according to the VAS.
- Pregnant or breastfeeding woman.
- Renal insufficiency with creatinine clearance \leq 60 ml/min.
