Key Eligibility Criteria

Inclusion (8)

- The patient should be e18 years of age.
- Restorable mature permanent 1st and 2nd Mandibular molars with deep caries (reaching inner quarter of dentine)
- Tooth should give positive response to pulp sensibility testing.
- Clinical diagnosis of moderate pulpitis.
- Radiographic finding of periapical index (PAI) score d2.

Exclusion (8)

- Teeth with immature roots.
- Pulp exposure after incomplete caries excavation.
- No pulp exposure after complete caries excavation.
- Bleeding could not be controlled in 5 minutes.
- Signs of pulpal necrosis, sinus tract, swelling, insufficient bleeding after pulp exposure.
