Inclusion (9)

- Age \geq 18 ys
- Premorbid modified Rankin Scale score of 0-2
- WFNS I-IV at enrollment
- Aneurysm occlusion has occurred through open or endovascular means
- Minimum 24 hours elapsed after aneurysm occlusion

... and 4 more (see full listing online)

Exclusion (5)

- Age under 18 years
- Traumatic subarachnoid hemorrhage
- Incapacitated or limited capacity for action before ictus
- Confirmed pregnancy
- Aneurysm multiplicity (unless all aneurysms are treated)
