Key Eligibility Criteria

Inclusion (3)

- Age from 20 to 40 years.
- Women with uterine ectopic pregnancy (interstitial pregnancy, cervical pregnancy, or cesarean scar pregnancy).
- Gestational age is less than 9 weeks, the embryo size is smaller than 10 mm, and the serum beta-human chorionic gonadotropin (hCG) levels are less than 10,000 mIU/mL.

Exclusion (7)

- Patients with basal beta hCG levels less than 1500 mIU/MI.
- Any contraindications to MTX as a hepatic disorder, renal disorder and thrombocytopenia
- Diabetes mellitus.
- Severe vaginal bleeding or hemodynamic changes or hemoperitoneum.
- History of cancer.
