Key Eligibility Criteria

Inclusion (5)

- years of age minimum
- Acute spinal cord injury for less than 24 hours
- Injury ranging from mild spinal cord injury where motor function is preserved (AIS A) to complete injury where there is no motor or sensory function below the level of the injury (AIS D)
- Medically stable to undergo routine dorsal decompression, spinal realignment
- and stabilizing with segmental instrumentation

Exclusion (8)

- Younger than 18 years old
- Neurological lower extremity exam missing or intact
- Traumatic head injury with a Glasgow score of 11 or lower
- Cord injury level caudal to T10 (thoracic spine level 10)
- A known sensitivity to lipid microsphere or its components, such as polyethylene glycol (PEG)
