Key Eligibility Criteria

Inclusion (3)

- Age ≤ 18 years . Symptomatic gallbladder stones (biliary colic, fever, vomiting, positive Murphy sign) .
- Congenital hemolytic anemia with gallbladder stones. Asymptomatic patient with gallbladder stones ≤ 5 mm after medical treatment (Ursodeoxycholic acid) for 1year .
- Imaging criteria (large gallbladder stone ≤ 1 cm diameter , gallbladder thickness ≤ 3 mm) either symptomatic or asymptomatic .

Exclusion (1)

- Age > 18 years. Asymptomatic patients who improved after follow up and medical treatment . Biliary anomaly as choledochal cyst , biliary stricture. Common bile duct stones .
