Key Eligibility Criteria

Inclusion (6)

- Capacity and willingness to sign consent
- Patient willingness to commit to and complete study over a 30-day time period
- Confirmed diagnosis of moderate to severe OSA (AHI \geq 15)
- OSA caused by upper airway obstruction
- CPAP non-compliant where CPAP compliance is defined as using CPAP for at least 4 hours a night for at least 70% of nights or interest in an alternative sleep apnea therapy
- ... and 1 more (see full listing online)

Exclusion (14)

- Within 3 months of initiating CPAP use, and actively using CPAP
- Supraglottic airway collapse
- Distal airway stenosis
- Tracheobronchomalacia
- Currently pregnant
- ... and 9 more (see full listing online)
