Key Eligibility Criteria

Inclusion (3)

- Patients over 18 years of age and
- Patients with moderately or severely calcified bifurcation lesions (lateral vessel $\geq 2\text{mm}$), candidates for PCI with coronary stent implantation, in whom there is the possibility of adequate clinical follow-up at 1 year and
- Patients agree to participate in the study, by signing the Informed Consent.

Exclusion (9)

- Patients with revascularization of the artery to be treated within 9 months prior to the index procedure.
- Patients with contraindication for the use of Orbital Atherectomy:
- Patients in cardiogenic shock.
- Patients with Thrombotic lesions.
- Patients with Vascular graft disease.
