Key Eligibility Criteria

Inclusion (7)

- Age ≥18 years
- Patients with a confirmed diagnosis of lower limb arterial occlusion located in the common iliac or below, with a minimum of 2 cm of proximal patency in the common iliac
- Acute occlusion with symptom duration of 14 days or less at presentation
- ALI Rutherford Category I, IIa or IIb
- First-line treatment with the Indigo Aspiration System using Computer Assisted Vacuum Thrombectomy (CAVT) aspiration tubing ... and 2 more (see full listing online)

Exclusion (12)

- Life expectancy <1 year
- Target vessel size <2 mm
- Target thrombus is in the aorta or isolated profunda artery
- Prior major amputation (proximal to the tarsometatarsal joint) in the target limb
- Prior minor amputation in the target limb within the past 6 months that is not completely healed or cannot bear weight ... and 7 more (see full listing online)
