Key Eligibility Criteria

Inclusion (4)

- Female (XX genotype, assigned female at birth)
- Age 18-40
- Finding of suspected uni- or bi-lateral ovarian endometrioma(ta) of e 2cm on TVUSS and/or pelvic MRI scan (TVUSS, a uni- or multi-locular ovarian cystic lesion with low level echoes and diffuse homogeneous ground glass appearance; MRI any of, ovarian lesion hyperintense T1 without loss of signal on T1 fat-suppressed images, hypointense T2 exhibiting shading sign and/or T2 dark spot sign, variable restricted diffusion on DWI)
- Appropriate to be listed for laparoscopic excision of endometrioma (Endometrioma e2cm, pain symptoms attributable to endometriosis where medical management is unsuccessful or unacceptable to the patient, to facilitate ART)

Exclusion (7)

- Postmenopausal status
- Suspicion of malignancy
- Unable to undergo TVUSS
- Declines to take part in the study
- Unable to understand verbal or written information in English
