Key Eligibility Criteria

Inclusion (4)

- Patients of either sex
- American Society Anesthesiologists physical (ASA) status II-III
- age between 18-65 years old
- Body mass index (BMI) ≥ 35 kg/m² with comorbidity or ≥ 40 kg/m² -- undergoing laparoscopic sleeve gastrectomy with intraoperative surgeon performed laparoscopic paragastric autonomic neural blockade..

Exclusion (8)

- Allergy to experimental drugs.
- Known to have long QT, previous history of postoperative nausea and vomiting
- Abuse of alcohol, analgesia, or sedative antidepressant drugs
- Chronic pain disorders
- History of previous upper gastrointestinal system surgery, those with surgery-related complications during or after surgery.
