Key Eligibility Criteria

Inclusion (6)

- years of age;
- Men and women;
- Diagnosis of IBS from a healthcare provider with current report of pain (volunteers asked to bring provider-verification of IBS diagnosis based on Rome IV criteria to initial study appointment);
- Experiencing moderate pain (e3 out of 10 on numeric rating scale \[NRS\]) at least 4 days of the week and lasting previous three months;
- Daily access to a computer connected to the internet; and
- ... and 1 more (see full listing online)

Exclusion (8)

- Other chronic pain condition;
- Celiac disease or inflammatory bowel disease;
- Diabetes mellitus;
- severe psychiatric condition requiring inpatient treatment in previous 6 months;
- Pregnancy or lactation;
- ... and 3 more (see full listing online)
