Inclusion (4)

- Children aged 3-12 years.
- Diagnosed with OSA due to adenoid and/or tonsillar hypertrophy.
- IQ \geq 85.
- Parental consent for participation.

Exclusion (3)

- Other primary sleep disorders (e.g., narcolepsy, restless leg syndrome).
- Developmental delay, epilepsy, or other neurological/metabolic disorders.
- Chronic diseases or history of head trauma.
