Key Eligibility Criteria

Inclusion (4)

- clinical indication for CTO PCI as determined by the local heart team (presence of angina or equivalent symptoms and/or documented ischemia or viability)
- at least difficult native CTO lesion with J-CTO difficulty score e2 points on invasive angiography
- angiographic suitability for both ADR and the retrograde strategy as assessed by 2 independent hybrid CTO PCI operators
- informed consent for participation in the study

Exclusion (10)

- <18 years of age
- acute myocardial infarction
- cardiogenic shock
- severe valvular disease
- estimated life expectancy <1 year
- ... and 5 more (see full listing online)
