Key Eligibility Criteria

Inclusion (10)

- Signed informed consent.
 - Age e 18 years.
 - Willing to comply with the protocol.
 - Male or non-pregnant (negative urine pregnancy test in female subjects of child-bearing potential), non-lactating females.
 - Primary palmar hyperhidrosis for at least 6 months duration.
- ... and 5 more (see full listing online)

Exclusion (18)

- Subjects who have taken or are currently taking Qbrexza (glycopyrronium) 2.4% within 4 weeks of baseline
 - Prior surgical procedure for hyperhidrosis.
 - Iontophoresis for the palms within 4 weeks of Baseline.
 - Treatment with botulinum toxin (e.g., Botox) for palmar hyperhidrosis within 6 months of Baseline.
 - Subjects who are actively participating in an experimental therapy study or who received experimental therapy within 30 days or 5 half-lives (whichever is longer) of the Baseline Visit.
