Plain Language Summary

This study is testing a surgical technique called sentinel lymph node biopsy in women with early-stage ovarian cancer. The goal is to see if surgeons can identify the first lymph nodes that cancer might spread to, potentially reducing the need to remove large numbers of lymph nodes.

****You may be eligible if...****

- You are female, aged 18 or older
- You have been diagnosed with ovarian cancer (any type of epithelial cancer) in an early stage (FIGO stage I or II)
- You are scheduled for staging surgery or exploratory surgery for a suspected early-stage ovarian tumor
- You have signed a consent form before any study procedures begin

****You may NOT be eligible if...****

- You have advanced-stage ovarian cancer beyond FIGO stage II
- You have already received chemotherapy or radiation for this cancer
- You do not meet surgical eligibility requirements

Talk to your doctor to see if this trial is right for you.

Key Eligibility Criteria

Inclusion (3)

- Signed informed consent prior to the performance of any procedure related to the clinical trial.
- Female, 18 years of age or older at the time of inclusion.
- Patients with a histopathological diagnosis of malignant ovarian tumor in a deferred study (any epithelial histology), in apparent early stage FIGO I-II, proposed for staging surgery, or patients with suspected malignant ovarian tumor in apparent early stage FIGO I-II, who will undergo exploratory laparotomy and operative biopsy, and if positive, will undergo staging surgery.

Exclusion (8)

- Failure to obtain informed consent or revocation of informed consent.
- Under 18 years of age at the time of inclusion.
- Previous history of vascular surgery on the aorta, vena cava, or pelvic vessels.
- Previous pelvic or paraaortic lymphatic surgery.
- Previous lymphoma.
