Key Eligibility Criteria

Inclusion (4)

- Participant has a diagnosis of EM with or without aura according to current International Classification of Headache Disorders (Edition 3 and Edition 4 alpha) criteria for e 12 months and is able to distinguish migraine headaches from all other types of headaches;
- Participant age \leq 50 years at the time of migraine onset;
- Participant meeting the following headache and migraine day criteria in each of the 3 months prior to screening: history of d 14 headache days per month and history of 6 to 14 migraine days per month; and
- During the last 28 days of the screening period, participant experiencing: d 14 headache days and 6 to 14 migraine days that qualify as such per the headache diary.

Exclusion (6)

- Diagnosis of chronic migraine;
 - Diagnosis of other primary headache types, except tension-type headache, which is permitted;
 - Diagnosis of aura without headache, migraine with brainstem aura, hemicrania continua, hypnic headache, hemiplegic migraine, retinal migraine, persistent aura without infarction, migraine aura-triggered seizure, or previous migrainous infarction;
 - Diagnosis of secondary headache types, except medication overuse headache, which is permitted;
 - Currently taking \geq 1 prescribed drug for the preventive treatment of migraine;
