Plain Language Summary

This study is testing whether liraglutide (a GLP-1 medication commonly used for type 2 diabetes and weight loss) can also help people with a rare genetic type of diabetes called MODY (Maturity-Onset Diabetes of the Young).

****You may be eligible if:****

- You have been diagnosed with MODY confirmed through genetic testing
- Your HbA1c (average blood sugar level over 3 months) is above 6.5%, indicating blood sugar is not fully controlled

****You may NOT be eligible if:****

- You have had a severe allergic reaction to GLP-1 medications
- You are already taking a GLP-1 medication
- You are currently pregnant or plan to become pregnant
- You have a personal or family history of medullary thyroid cancer or pancreatitis
- You have active kidney disease
- You have had severely low blood sugar (below 50 mg/dL) in the past 3 months
- Your HbA1c is above 10% (very poorly controlled diabetes)

Talk to your doctor to see if this trial is right for you.

Key Eligibility Criteria

Inclusion (2)

- Diagnosis of MODY via genetic testing
- HgbA1c \geq 6.5%

Exclusion (12)

- History of anaphylaxis to GLP-1 receptor agonists
- Already taking GLP-1 receptor agonists
- on medications within the stimulant class
- have had bariatric surgery
- personal or family history of cancer, especially medullary thyroid cancer
- ... and 7 more (see full listing online)
