Key Eligibility Criteria

Inclusion (11)

- Group 1 (communicating hydrocephalus):
- Adult patients ≥ 60
- With gait apraxia
- With or without cognitive impairment
- Urinary dysfunction
- ... and 6 more (see full listing online)

Exclusion (13)

- Asymptomatic hydrocephalus
- High pressure-hydrocephalus
- Serious head injury within 5 years of presentation or a clear secondary cause (e.g. brain infection)
- History of childhood gait disturbance
- Clear alternative explanation for symptoms (e.g. Parkinson's disease with limb rigidity, peripheral neuropathy with sensory ataxia, cervical myelopathy).
