## Key Eligibility Criteria

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### Inclusion (6)

- IASP diagnosis of peripheral neuropathic pain;
- At least three months after the onset of pain;
- At least moderate pain intensity (e 3 assessed by VAS or NRS);
- years or older;
- Stable medical treatment from 2 weeks before allocation to the end of the trial;
- ... and 1 more (see full listing online)

### Exclusion (6)

- Contradictions to TMS treatment, such as metal implants or seizure;
- Serious psychiatric disorder (Hamilton Depression Rating Scale score e 35 or Hamilton Anxiety Rating Scale score e 29);
- Aphasia or cognitive disorders (Mini mental state examination d 24);
- Severe clinical disorders caused by tumor or other conditions;
- Severe cardiopulmonary dysfunction or extreme weakness;
- ... and 1 more (see full listing online)
